Playground Spring Clean.

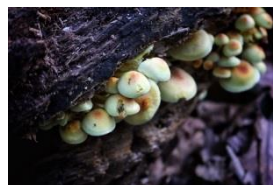

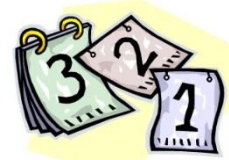
